

Benjamin Ng Shui Tai
(Demised – 2nd April 2010)



Mr. Benjamin Ng Shui Tai was the youngest among 10 siblings. He grew up in the small town of Bentong, Pahang. His late mother was a teacher and his father ran a book shop. Due to financial constraint, Ben was the only fortunate one that could pursue higher education, with the help of all his brothers and sisters, financially and morally.

Ben was called to the degree of an Utter Barrister by the Honourable Society of Middle Temple in 1984 and admitted to the Malaysian Bar in 1985. Thereafter, he practiced as a legal assistant in Messrs Philip Choong & Co before setting up his own practice under the name and style of Messrs Shui Tai in 1986. With his enterprising spirit and love for the law, he had successfully built the Firm which now has three offices with 16 lawyers.

Being a “kampung” boy at heart and with his humble upbringing, Ben was always kind and helpful to all those around him. Despite his success in his career, he remained a simple man till his sudden demise on 2-4-2010 due to complications after a surgery. He was only 53 years old then. His parting words were “Goodbye till we meet again on the shores far far away”.
